INTRODUCTION

Performers Theatre Company will be performing Little Shop of Horrors with the show dates confirmed as:

Thursday 29th October 2026 (7:30pm)

Friday 30th October 2026 (2pm & 7:30pm)

Saturday 31st October 2026 (11am & 4pm)

REHEARSALS

A rehearsal schedule is available on the website prior to Open Auditions. This is subject to change.

Rehearsals will commence **from Wednesday 3rd June 2026.**

Rehearsals will take place once a week at Park Community School on a **Wednesday evening between 6pm and 8pm.** Times may vary throughout the rehearsal process.

Rehearsals will become more frequent as the show dates draw closer.

There will be a **week long rehearsal block from Monday 17th August to Friday 21st August 2026.** These rehearsals will take place from 10am-4pm. All cast will be required for these dates.

Show week will **commence from Monday 26th October** with rehearsals taking place every day (times will vary). A **tech rehearsal will take place on Tuesday 27th October** and a **dress rehearsal on Wednesday 28th October.** All cast will be required for show week.

F E E S

There are no fees to audition.

Rehearsals will cost **£10 per session.** Half day rehearsals (17th - 21st August & 25th / 26th October) cost **£20 per session** and full day rehearsals (27th / 28th October) cost **£35 per session.**

There are three options to pay for rehearsal fees:

- 1. Pay fees upfront (£370) or;*
- 2. Spread cost equally over 5 months (£74 per month – starting June)*
- 3. Pay for rehearsals monthly (cost will vary depending on the number of rehearsals (i.e. June has 4 rehearsals so this would equate to £32)*

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY CHILD DECIDES THEY NO LONGER WANT TO PARTICIPATE?

We appreciate that sometimes children decide they are no longer interested or feel that they can commit to the rehearsal process. Whilst we understand this, it is simply not a good enough reason and can put huge pressure on the cast, crew and production as a whole.

As a result – the following rules will apply:

- If your child **drops out before the 1st July 2026**, there will be a **£25 charge**.
- If your child **drops out between 1st July and 28th August**, there will be a **£50 charge**.
- If your child **drops out after 28th August**, they will incur a **£100 charge**.

There will be no refunds for any payments already made for rehearsals.

All children who decide they no longer want to participate will be expected to return all scripts and rehearsal material.

Children who drop out after 28th August will also lose the privilege of auditioning for any future productions with us (unless the reason for removing your child is in an exceptional circumstance approved by the Principal). We will have to recast their role, and this places immense pressure on the production team and cast. We do not believe it would be fair to place future casts in similar positions if you are unable to commit your child to what we are offering.

EXPECTATIONS

Your child is expected to attend every rehearsal unless they are unwell or there is an exceptional circumstance*. This must be approved by the Principal. The rehearsal process is vital in producing a successful production - if a child is missing rehearsals, this impacts on not only their role but the rest of the cast.

Please consider this when auditioning.

In line with our main school Code of Conduct, your child must always show respect, to both other children and adults. If this is not being reflected in your child, they will be removed from the production without hesitation.

Electronics should not be brought to rehearsals. If any electronic (i.e. mobile phone) is brought to rehearsals, it must either be given to a member of staff or placed in a bag/coat.

Those children enrolled at Performers must wear their uniform to every rehearsal. Those not enrolled must wear navy blue/black clothing.

As a cast member, your child will be expected to sell at least five tickets.

Scripts have to be returned following the production – only pencil can be used to make notes, and these markings must be removed when returning to Performers Theatre Company. Any script defaced or not in a suitable condition will incur a £25 fine.

PHOTOGRAPHY

If your child is successful at audition, it will automatically be assumed that they can have photos/videos taken of them. These will be shared on social media and the website. If you **DO NOT** consent to this, you **MUST** contact Performers Theatre Company as soon as your child is given a place in the production.
